APK basketball senior spotlight: Jude Angervil & Larson Taylor

This week I got to talk to, and get to know, the Apopka Basketball team's incoming seniors about their transition from players to leaders on the team. Jude Angervil and Larson Taylor are two of the four seniors for the 2024-25 season and are already preparing for a deep playoff run.

Last year the team had three seniors – now they have four. Two big men and two guards who can also play forwards if need be. Taylor and Angervil are the team's big guys in the paint who are the heart of the defense and huge playmakers off the glass whether going for second-chance looks themselves or finding the open man for an easy shot.

Even though they are incoming seniors, these two have been a key piece in Apopka's lineup for some time. Last season Larson and Angervil both had a majority of their games in the starting lineup and were main pieces in the offense and defense.

Last season in 28 games Taylor and Angervil had great stats on both sides of the ball.

Larson shot 53.4 percent from the field aver-

aging 7.9 points per game for a total of 221 points, he also averaged 5.6 rebounds per game (2.7 offensive, 2.9 defensive), three second-chance points per game, .2 blocks, and 2.2 turnovers per game.

Angervil shot 43 percent from the field and collected 244 points averaging 8.7 per game. Angervil also collected 120 rebounds averaging 4.3 per game (2.1 offensive, 2.2 defensive) while also grabbing 2.1 second chance points, one steal, .3 blocks, and 2.4 turnovers per game.

With those numbers as juniors, their play will only grow exponentially by

the time basketball comes around in winter. And that is what summer is all about for the Apopka basketball squad – getting better and finding comfort in their new roles.

I got to talk to all four seniors about their journeys through basketball and their approach to this year. What I got from it was that each one of them has huge expectations and is working every day to make those dreams a reality come winter.

Jude Angervil:
#4 Forward

Angervil started playing basketball in the summer of eighth grade, and

he only started playing because his parents wouldn't let him play football – Angervil and I had that in common. He told me that he has really enjoyed the summer so far just because he's been able to be with his teammates and create bonds with new upcoming varsity players.

Angervil said he is excited, but also nervous, about his new role as one of the team's leaders. He said he doesn't really know what to expect yet, but this is his last year so it's time to make it count. Angervil went on to say that the

This will be a continuation of my senior spotlight series on the Apopka Basketball team focusing on Jermichael Johnson, and Jahi Bowden. This year Johnson and Bowden will be the teams' primary scorers and who coach Scott Williams will run the offense through and around.

Last year the team had three seniors – now they have four. Two big men and two guards who can also play forwards if need be. Johnson and Bowden are the teams' scorers and playmakers; creating space and shots for themselves and their teammates is their main goal.

Johnson led the team in points and assists last season with 282 points with a 43.2 shooting percentage averaging 10.1 points a game and 2.1 assists a game and collected 58 over the season. Johnson also led the team in rebounds with 191 total averaging 6.8 per game (2.9 offensive, 4 defensive). But Johnson is just as much of a force on defense as he is on offense with 53 deflections, 57 steals, and eight blocks last season.

Bowden led the team in blocks tied with Angervil with nine. He also collected 164 points averaging 5.9 per game with a 39.5 shooting percentage. Bowden was second on the team in assists tied with Daren Leath for 34 averaging 1.2 per game. He also had 38 steals (1.4 a game), 110 rebounds (3.9 a game, 1.4 offensive, 2.5 defensive), 41 deflections (1.5 a game), and averaged 2.4 turnovers a game.

I asked Johnson and Bowden the same questions

as Larson Taylor and Jude Angervil but got different responses from the team's playmakers.

Jermichael Johnson: #3 Forward/Guard

Johnson, like I explained, is the team's go-to guy for points and nearly everything else. This kid is an athletic freak who is just as much of a pain to deal with on offense as he is trying to get by on defense. When talking to him, I expected his personality to match his play style – loud, exciting, and turned up to 11. But he was very calm, quiet, and quick to the point. Mind you, the boys had just gotten out of practice, but I was expecting a very energetic demeanor, but I was surprised.

When I asked Johnson when he started playing ball, he started to recollect and gave me a pause.

"I mean... to be honest, when I came out of the womb."

Johnson said that basketball was always a part of his life as everyone in his family had played. He said he was destined to play basketball.

When talking about the summer so far and how he's felt about the work they've put in as a team, Johnson said it's all about the bond that they are creating, but more than that, it's just fun to be out there with his boys. He told me that being a senior and now a leader of this team has all hit rather fast and out of nowhere.

"It's crazy, it all moves so fast. Now that I am at this point, it feels like I only just started here."

Johnson went on to say that the most important quality in a leader, in his eyes, is their ability to communicate in a positive manner.

"I feel like it's the way you talk to your teammates. Like if someone messes up, just tell them to keep their head high and keep on going."

Johnson's team goals are much like the other senior leaders. Make it to playoffs, then make it to Lakeland for the FHSAA State Championship. But he also talked about his personal goals for this season.

"My personal goal is to make a name for myself and Apopka and bring excitement back to Apopka. But I also really want to be able to go play ball at a good school."

Johnson told me that right now he's not working on any one thing, it's more just everything about his game that he is trying to improve. But he says that he's been working a lot on his shot mechanics.

When talking about his game, Johnson told me that his game is made more for finishing at the rim or driving through the lane, but when he can shoot effectively, it opens up the game – not just for him, but for everyone else.

"I mean, I'm better in the paint, but I feel like when I'm knocking it down from the three, it opens up the game more because they have to worry about my shot, so if they have a high close-out on me, I'm going right to the basket."

Johnson then said his go-to move is an in-and-out cross-up to a high pick-up layup. When playing defense, Johnson is like a warden. He told me when he's guarding somebody they might as well be in jail because they aren't going anywhere.

Johnson said he's got-


Hebb & Kraine catch five bass weighing in at 23.05 pounds

Hello Folks,
 We are still gettin' a few drops here and there, so I'm very thankful we are gettin' some rain. I hope you had a great weekend and hopefully you got a chance to do some fishin'.
 Kyle at Bitter's Bait & Tackle reports that the bluegill and shellcracker season has completed. Folks took advantage of last week's full moon to get in on the last of the bluegills. I'm sure there may be a few stragglers around,

but most of the panfish are through beddin' for this year.
 The bass fishin' on the Harris Chain hasn't been too bad lately. The X-treme Bass Series held a tournament on the chain last weekend and the team of Kim Hebb and John Kraine brought 5 bass to the scales that weighed in at 23.05 pounds. They also had a big bass in their sack that weighed in at 8.50 pounds. The team of Eric Krause and James Kend-

rick had the biggest bass that weighed 8.51 pounds. Can you imagine losin' the big bass pot by .01 tenth of an ounce? The big bass pot was worth \$240 dollars.
 Kyle also reports that the bass fishin' on the Mait land Chain has been pretty good. Folks are fishin' the chain early mornin' or late evenin'. Most of the bass are bein' caught around the submerged hydrilla and eel-grass beds. You can rip a lipless crank-bait through the grass for some good re-

sults, or fish plastic worms in the grass as well.
 The Butler Chain has been good for catchin' keeper-size bass. You can also catch some schoolers when they come up around the boat. Try usin' a noisy top-water bait or a chatter-bait when they come up. With these hot days, you may need to fish a little deeper around the submerged pepper grass beds. The grass provides some shade for the bass and the water is a little cooler. It's that time of year when you need to slow down your retrieve, especially if you are fishin' plastic worms or slow-sinkin' Senko type baits. The bass need time to make up their mind if they are goin' to bite, or

 My fishin' buddy Rick is probably the best at this as anyone. Rick picks a spot, and casts to it. Then he lets his worm just lay there until he moves it, or a bass picks it up and starts to swim off with his worm. Back in the day, we called it "Dead Stickin'".
 Kyle also reports that the bass fishin' on West



Forwards: Angervil has the same goals as the rest of the seniors

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most important qualities in a leader are patience and the ability to be calm in any situation.

Angervil and all of the other seniors really have the same goal as a team - make it to Lakeland and be in the fight for the FHSAA State Championship. But each one of them has separate personal goals for the next few months.

"Our team goal is to make it to Lakeland and have a great record. My personal goal is to get my name and Apopka's name out there and bring excitement to Apopka," said Angervil.

Right now, Angervil is focused on improving his conditioning and his athleticism as he says those are the parts of his game that are lacking but he's also focused on his finesse and finishing at the rim. I also asked him if he prefers to shoot from the field or finish at the rim to which he gave a funny response that coach Scott Williams probably doesn't want to hear.

"Finish at the rim... Nah I mean honestly; I want to shoot the ball. I just want to shoot the ball," Angervil said while he and Jeremichael Johnson laughed.

He then told me his go-to move to get a bucket right now is a hop-step to the other side of where his opponent's feet are facing.

On defense, Angervil is always and only thinking about staying between his man and the basket but he still needs to work on his discipline in the paint. This ties into what Angervil said is the best advice he's gotten about basketball which is to be patient.

"The game becomes easier when you slow it down for yourself."

Angervil says he sees his role as the leader and the energy guy. He said as a senior that he wants to be a leader on and off the court.

We took a second to talk about last season's highs and lows where he and a lot of his teammates shared the same sentiments. He said the high was making it to playoffs through the adversity the team faced last year with their less-than-spectacular record. But the lows were losing games that he and the team feel like they shouldn't have lost.

I asked him why he thinks the team lost those games last year and he said that the team didn't care enough but that that was going to change this year.

"We just didn't care enough. This year we want to care more and leave everything on the court every game. Last year we left stuff on the court that we should've never left."

Angervil said he's learned a lot over his years on the team and that he will bring that with him as a leader.

"I learned to always stay calm no matter that situation and to never give up until the clock hits zero."

One of my last questions was a fun one to see what kind of players each of the seniors was. It was, "What is more important, defense or offense?" Angervil laughing again said offense is more important than defense.

Before our interview was over Angervil had one last thing to say about his game. It was that he likes to be flashy and exciting with his play.

"I hate a boring play style. I would rather do something flashy than sit there and do box drills. I could score 10 and I still

wouldn't be happy playing like that."

So, if you come out to watch the boys play look for number 4 trying to do something flashy and then look for coach Williams, who will probably have a hand over his face.

Larson Taylor: #5 Forward

Taylor told me he started playing ball when he was in sixth grade and stuck with it because it came to him easily.

"Uhhh... I don't know. It really just came to me. I just tried out one year and I made it - so I kept going."

Taylor told me he has really come into his own this summer because of constantly working with and being around all of his teammates.

"Summer has really helped us come together as a team for the upcoming season. It's been great to build that chemistry between us by being around each other more," Taylor said.

I asked how he felt about his new role on the team as a leader and not just a player and Taylor was a bit hesitant but ready for the challenge and the opportunity.

"I mean I don't know. It does feel kind of different. There's a lot of responsibility that comes with it and you have to really be on the same page because this is us, it's our time. We got to be on point because our teammates follow our lead."

Larson told me the most important qualities in a leader are a voice that others will listen to and respect, but most of all their actions on and off the court.

When talking about personal and team goals,

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Forwards: Taylor is working on conditioning and his jump shot

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Taylor was adamant about what he wanted for himself and the team.

"For my personal goal, I really want to try and get an offer to play college ball, and I want to have a certain shooting percentage when I'm on the court. And for our team, I want us to get into playoffs, then make it to Lakeland and shock some people. Because I know that's something that we can do.

Taylor said that right now he's working on his conditioning and the mechanics of his jump shot. He also told me that his game

is more built for finishing at the rim than it is for shooting from the field. When we talked about his game, I asked what his go-to move was when he's one-on-one with a defender in transition. Before Taylor could finish his answer, the other seniors laughed in unison when they heard his go-to move.

"Oh, I'm going to have to hit them with a spin..." in the middle of his answer Jermichael Johnson, Jahi Bowden, and Angervil all laughed. Taylor went on through the laughs and said, "No, no, no, no, no, listen, if he is coming towards me,

I'm going to have to hit him with a spin or like a euro (step)."

As he finished Angervil chimed in to say "This man has never hit a spin move in his life. And if he has, it never went in." The boys laughed and Taylor joined in good fun.

When we talked about defense, Taylor said that he's most focused on communication and keeping his man from getting close to the rim. He told me his goal is to get his man to pass the ball away.

"The best advice I've ever gotten was really to just be patient and let the

game come to you. Don't rush it."

I asked Taylor what he saw his role to be when he was on the floor.

"On the offensive end my role is to get as many offensive rebounds as I can and either put them back up or try to open up the floor and move the ball to my teammates' hands. And on the defensive end, I try to make sure that I'm always talking but I want to get stops and keep the ball out of the paint."

I asked him the same question I asked of all the other seniors about last season's highs and lows and

how they plan to improve this season.

"The highs were kind of weird because there was a point in the season where we weren't looking at playoffs, and then we ended up making it. So, that's a high. But then we lost in the first round. For this upcoming season though, I know we are going to go further than we did last year in playoffs."

Taylor told me that the biggest thing he has learned over his time with the team that will help him as a leader is that he knows that the whole team needs to be on the same page on and off the

court and all have the same mentality for their goals to come to fruition.

The last thing we talked about was what was more important: defense or offense. Taylor quickly responded defense, with no hesitation.

These two big men for the Apopka basketball team are the heart of the defense and what makes every team stay away from the paint when they face the Blue Darters. Make sure to look out for these guys making huge strides in their game come winter.

Guards: Johnson and Bowden are the energy guys who are always looking for a momentum swinging play

ten a lot of advice over the years, but two things have stuck with him the most.

"I got two, really. Coach Williams always says to worry about the next play. And that basketball is just a game. A lot of people will get too caught up in the physicality, and you just got to remember to have fun with it because it's just a game."

Johnson told me he sees his role on the court as the energy guy and the guy who can always go get a bucket for the team. We then talked about the highs and lows of last season where he repeated the same thing all the seniors said: "We lost too many games we shouldn't have."

"I mean I'm happy we made it to playoffs but we lost a whole bunch of games we shouldn't have lost. We took plays off that really hurt us and our turnovers really killed us.

Johnson said the things that he's learned over the seasons that will help him as a leader this year are being the loudest on the court and playing like a dog on both ends of the ball.

When I asked Johnson

what was more important, defense or offense, Jude Angervil chimed in to say offense was more important. Johnson just rolled his eyes and said, "It's defense man. Defense is always more important."

Johnson left me with something unique about his game. Johnson is ambidextrous on the court being able to play with his left and his right with similar strength and coordination. He also told me that he can guard all five positions with his defensive prowess.

"I'm left-handed, but my right is stronger than my left. Not a lot of people know that. I can always attack you left or right. So their coaches (the opponents' coaches) will tell them (Johnson's defender) to send him to his weak hand; he's a righty. But they don't know that that's really my stronger hand. Honestly, even coach Williams didn't see it at first, but now he sees it."

Johnson, or Mike as his team calls him, has been the go-to guy for points since last season. This year he'll have two jobs. To be the leader on the court and the scoreboard. But I think he's got it covered.

Jahi Bowden: #10 Guard

Bowden, like Johnson, is a coach's dream. An all-around player that leaves nothing on the court every game. He gives his all every play, and you can tell by his passion when things go right or wrong. With a smaller frame than most of the seniors I've talked about so far, he's your archetype for a true guard; quick, decisive, and has great vision on both sides of the ball.

Bowden told me he started playing basketball in sixth grade and started taking it seriously in seventh grade. He went on to say he only started playing basketball because he stopped playing soccer. He said he took a year off from sports and then found basketball in middle school.

Bowden told me summer has been great for him and the team as they have been around each other so much since May.

"It's good being around your teammates so much because you want to win championships with them. So, it's been good to get that early work in."

Bowden said that it's been different this year,

even from the start, with him expected to be a leader. He said he's been watching the team's leaders for the last two seasons and has learned a lot from them.

"They (former leaders on the team) gave me a great example of what a leader should be like."

Bowden then told me that communication and being coachable is the most important aspect of being a leader in his eyes.

"Communication and being coachable. You gotta be coachable so the other guys will follow."

His personal goal for this year is to get himself an offer to play basketball at the next level as that's always been a childhood dream. He also wants to be a main contributor to the team; he says he wants to average around 15 points a game this season.

"Our team goal is to win districts, have a better record than last year, and get to Lakeland."

Bowden says he's been working on everything about his game but mostly his shot and his ball handling.

"I've been working on my shot and ball handling...really just every-

thing because everything can always be better."

He said that his game is a better fit for driving down the lane and finishing at the rim but that shooting really opens up his opportunities when ball handling and trying to make a play. He then said his go-to move in a one-on-one in transition is full contact.

"I'm either going to try to go right through your chest or just dunk it on you."

Bowden said the only thing going through his head when guarding his man is getting the ball out of his hands as soon as possible. The best advice he's ever gotten about playing the game is being patient and always looking towards the next play, not letting one play take over his head space.

When talking about what he sees his role as on the team, Bowden said he's a scorer. He said he's also the energy guy on both sides of the ball always looking for the play that'll turn everything around and give the team some momentum.

"The highs were making it to playoffs through all the adversity we had. Some

things just weren't going our way, but we just kept fighting. The lows were really just us losing a lot. This upcoming season I would say we're just coming for anybody that gets in our way," Bowden said about the highs and lows of last season and how he feels about the upcoming season.

Bowden talked a bit about what he's learned over the years from past leaders that will help him during this transition.

"I would say learning how to communicate with your teammates. At the end of the day, you are still just part of the team but also a leader, so just making sure you can relate to them."

Bowden also told me that in his eyes, defense is more important than offense... by a small margin. And before we ended our interview, he wanted to make sure everyone reading this knew one thing: "I can dunk."

Johnson and Bowden are exciting and passionate on the floor, but always play better with a crowd. So make sure you come out to see the Apopka basketball team when winter sports roll around.
