Last weekend, while sugar plums and gumdrops were still on most people's minds, it was game time for the Apopka Blue Darter boys basketball squad. The team traveled north to Gainesville for the Florida Get Down New Year's Showcase. The boys went undefeated beating both of their opponents in convincing fashion.

Starting with their first game on Friday, December 27, the boys were set to play against Business Engineering Science Tech (BEST) out of Atlanta, Georgia. BEST was ranked 89th in the state of Georgia with an 11-3 record. Even with the team being very

skilled, Apopka was able to collecting 18. get hot and pull away with

a decisive 68-49 win defeating the BEST Eagles by nearly 20 points. Head coach of the

Apopka Blue Darters Scott Williams told me that the game against BEST was the harder-fought matchup of the two games.

"They are a pretty good team. We were finally able to pull away in the second half, and we ended up winning by 19, which was a big win for us."

Apopka's Jermichael Johnson, Jahi Bowden, and Jude Angervil all had phenomenal outings against BEST. The three of them combined for 58 of the team's 68 points. Johnson and Bowden collected 20 points each with Angervil

was set to be against the Lithonia Bulldogs out of Lithonia Georgia. On Sunday, December 29, Apopka faced Lithonia and put another win up to complete their tournament run undefeated. The Blue Darters defeated Lithonia 56-21 in a game that was over from the start.

When Williams talked about the game against Lithonia, he said that Apopka simply overwhelmed them.

'We got on them and ahead of them early, and because of that, a lot of kids got a chance to play that don't get to play a lot, and that is always good for your season and good for your kids to be able to do that."






